Instructions for Completing the Kentucky Voter Registration Card

Must be a U.S. citizen • Must be 18 years of age on or before November 6, 2012

Cannot be a convicted felon unless pardoned by the Governor

Mark the appropriate reason box on the left side of the voter registration card that applies to the request: New Registration, Address Change,


Party Change, and Name Change

Must give the county in which the person lives. Phone numbers will allow us to contact them and make sure they know where to go to vote.

Must give complete Social Security Number and date of birth. Registration will be invalid without the complete Social Security Number and date of birth. These are two ways to verify the registered voter's identity. Social Security numbers are not released.

Fill in one of the boxes to select a party registration.

Questions A & B must be marked "yes." A "no" means the person is ineligible to register



Leave the following sections blank: Precinct Code, Precinct Name, Town, and Other Code. These sections are to be completed by the county clerk.

Mark gender and write last name, first name, middle name, and suffix.

Fill out the residential address where you live. Post Office boxes are not acceptable. Fill out the address where one receives mail if it is different from the residential address where one lives.

Must sign and date voter registration card.

Two witnesses are needed ONLY if individual cannot sign name and uses an "X" as a signature
